

INFORMATION FOR REGISTRATION
AS AN
“OWNER” OR “SYNDICATE”

Owner Registration

An application for registration as an *Owner* must be completed and lodged with the Greyhounds Queensland Limited. A person under the age of eighteen is not eligible to register as an *Owner*. No registration fee is payable.

A National Police Certificate is not required, unless specifically requested by Greyhounds Queensland Limited.

Registered *Owners* cannot train greyhounds and they cannot handle greyhounds at any race meeting or trial unless they are licenced as a Class, 1, 2 or 3 trainer or they are licenced as an Attendant.

A licensed Trainer must train greyhounds owned by a registered Owner. In the case of a greyhound owned by a registered *Owner* and registered for Stud duties the greyhound must be kennelled with a licensed Stud Master and the appropriate Authority to Breed registered with Greyhounds Queensland Limited.

Brood bitches, litters and greyhounds not currently being trained for racing may be kennelled at the property of the *Owner*.

Syndicate Registration

Syndicate registration is issued when 2 or more (maximum 19) people own a greyhound. The members must delegate one person as the Manager. Members may also appoint the Manager as an agent to act on their behalf. Once the Syndicate has been registered and if an agent is appointed GQL will require only the agent's signature when lodging forms with Greyhounds Queensland Limited. The Agent does not have the Authority to remove members from the Syndicate.

A person under the age of eighteen is not eligible to register as a member of a *Syndicate*.

An application for registration as a *Syndicate* must be completed and lodged with the Greyhounds Queensland Limited. No registration fee is payable.

A National Police Certificate is not required for members unless specifically requested by Greyhounds Queensland Limited.

Syndicate members cannot train greyhounds owned by the Syndicate nor can they handle greyhounds at any race meeting or trial unless they hold a Class 1, 2 or 3 Trainer's licence or an Attendant's licence.

A licensed Trainer must train greyhounds owned by the registered *Syndicate*. In the case of a greyhound owned by a *Syndicate* and registered for Stud duties the greyhound must be kennelled with a licensed Stud Master and the appropriate Authority to Breed registered with Greyhounds Queensland Limited.

Broodbitches, litters and greyhounds not currently being trained for racing may be kennelled at the property of the *Syndicate* Manager or with the approval of GQL at the property of another *Syndicate* member.
