## RNA GREYHOUND SPECIAL STAKES

# QLD ROYAL NATIONAL SHOW, AUGUST 10-19, 2006

GRA Greyhound Special Stakes to be judged **13<sup>th</sup> August** in the Dog Pavilion, starting at 12 noon. Council Steward B.D. Vickers, Honorary Council Steward R. Underwood.

**Entry Fee: \$10.00. Entries close June 21.** Entries and fees to be lodged with the RNA on or before the closing date. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entries must be made on the special entry forms. Extra forms are available from the Authority and the RNA.

All dogs to be benched between 11 am and 11.45 am and after judging must be removed no later than 5 pm.

Entrance to the Dog Pavilion through the Symes Street entrance off St Paul's Terrace.

Subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971, and to the Constitution, Rules and By-Laws of the Association the following Regulations shall apply.

lodge with the Director 14 days prior to the first day of the show.

1. Judging will start at approximately 12 noon.
2. If any Exhibitor is not present when called for any Class or award the judging will be proceeded within his or her absence and the exhibit declared basent.
3. Any dog entered for the competition and actually in the Show may not be withdrawn from the competition without the consent of the Council Steward or Honorary Council Steward.
4. All dogs must be removed no later than 5 pm on the day of the Exhibition.
5. Kennel signs will be limited to a maximum of 60cm x 30cm displaying the name of the kennels and of exhibit. No other material may be displayed without the written consent of the RNA.
6. Should any question arise for which no specific guidance is provided, the matter shall be referred to the Council Steward or Honorary Council Steward whose decision in the matter shall be final.
7. All dogs must be benched with approved muzzle and leash. No more than one exhibit may occupy any one bench without the permission of the Steward. A dog may not be placed on the bench so as to be away from the view of the public and nothing that will affect the view of the public may be added to the bench.
8. No dogs will be removed from the benches at any time without the authority of the Council Steward or Honorary Council Steward.
9. It is an offence for any person to remove or alter the location or number of any exhibit from the benches allocated.
10. Prize ribbons will be awarded to each class on the following basis:
  - Under 8 exhibited –  
1st, 2nd, 3rd
  - 8-12 exhibited –  
1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th
  - Over 12 exhibited –  
1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th
11. Penalty for non-exhibition of dogs shall be \$10 for each dog not exhibited unless a Certificate be

Acceptance of entries: The attention of intending exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association of Queensland Act 1971 and to the Constitution, Rules and By-Laws of the Association in addition the Regulations which appear in this Schedule. ### CLASSES

#### Class 1

1st place \$250 plus trophy for Broodbitches named and registered with a Greyhounds Australasia affiliated authority at the closing of entries. Condition of this Class confirmation of service by way of registered Stud Dog name.

#### Class 2

1st place \$250 plus trophy for Greyhound Dogs registered with a Greyhounds Australasia affiliated authority which are over the age of 12 months at August 13, 2006.

#### Class 3

1st place \$250 plus trophy for Greyhound Bitches registered with a Greyhounds Australasia affiliated authority and which are over the age of 12 months at August 13, 2006.

#### Class 4

1st place \$250 plus trophy for Greyhound puppy dogs between the age of 6 and 12 months at August 13, 2006.

#### Class 5

1st place \$250 plus trophy for Greyhound puppy Bitches between the age of 6 and 12 months at August 13, 2006.
