### **Eligibility / Conditions: –**

- The QLD Group 5th Grade Statewide Challenge is open to greyhounds eligible for **Class 3 5th Grade at close of nominations.**
- Nominations for all Heats conducted at Gold Coast, Ipswich, Albion Park and Townsville will close on **Wednesday 25 May, 2005 at 8.30am with the GRA.** Greyhounds must be specifically nominated for the **QLD Group Statewide Challenge.** **A written nomination is required to ensure eligibility for the series.** The number of heats conducted will be determined by the number of nominations received per club.
- A \$22 nomination fee is payable at kennelling on the conduct of each club's heats.
- Greyhounds are eligible to compete in a series at one track **ONLY.**
- Trainer must be licenced in Queensland as at **25<sup>th</sup> February, 2005.**

- To be eligible, greyhounds **Must** have been domiciled in Queensland **(3) three months** prior to the close of nominations i.e. **25<sup>th</sup> February, 2005**. Any greyhound transferred into a kennel after 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2005 and not previously domiciled in Queensland will **NOT** be eligible. The only exception will be greyhounds named after this date and having its first race start in Queensland.
  - To be eligible to compete in the Townsville Series, greyhounds **Must** have been domiciled from **Gympie and North (3) three months** prior to the close of nominations i.e. **25<sup>th</sup> February, 2005**.
  - Heats and Finals will be conducted over the following distances: Gold Coast 457m, Ipswich 520m, Albion Park 520m and Townsville 498m. The Grand Final at Albion Park will be conducted over 520m.
  - First and second greyhounds from Albion Park, Gold Coast and Ipswich Finals shall represent their respective clubs in the Grand Final at Albion Park on Thursday 16th June 2005.
  - First placegetter in the Townsville Final shall represent that club in the Grand Final at Albion Park on Thursday 16th June, 2005.
  - The winner or first eligible greyhound from the North Queensland Intercity Challenge Grand Final in Mackay on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2005 will compete in the Grand Final at Albion Park on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2005.
  - Third placegetters from Albion Park, Gold Coast and Ipswich Finals will be balloted to determine reserves for the Grand Final at Albion Park on Thursday 16th June, 2005.
  - Heats at each track will carry normal 5<sup>th</sup> grade prize money. The Albion Park, Gold Coast and Ipswich finals will carry the following prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$1,500, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$500, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$300, 4<sup>th</sup> \$100. The Townsville final prize money will be: 1<sup>st</sup> \$1,500 (includes \$500 travelling expenses), 2<sup>nd</sup> \$500, \$300, 4<sup>th</sup> \$100. The first eligible greyhound from the Nth QLD Intercity Challenge Final will receive \$500 travelling expenses.
  - Trophies shall be presented to each club's Final winner with a presentation rug provided to all greyhounds representing their club for use in the Grand Final.
